


During the reporting period (19 - 27 May 2021), a total of 221 movements were recorded - 209 arrivals (8,117 individuals), 9 departures (263 individuals), and 3 transits (118 individuals). The largest arrivals were recorded in Nangade (2,473), Cidade de Pemba (1,982), Mueda (1,735) and Ibo (638). Departures were recorded in Mueda (200), Ibo (46), Metuge (12), and Namuno (5). The transitory movement were recorded in Nangade (95), Ibo (21), and Namuno (2).








MAIN DISTRICTS OF ORIGIN





MEANS OF DISPLACEMENT



REASON OF DISPLACEMENT




TYPE OF MOVEMENTS




MAIN ARRIVAL DISTRICTS







ABOUT THE EMERGENCY TRACKING TOOL (ETT)

Due to the volume and fluidity of population movements in Cabo Delgado, IOM's Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) rolled-out its Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) methodology in key areas presenting rapid and important movements of populations, in order to ensure the tracking of population on the move and to identify areas of displacement and settlements, and support the identification of critical needs. This aims to inform trends of displacements on a weekly basis and complement and feeds into the DTM larger exercise.

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) - Movement Alert is to collect information on large and sudden population movements, and to provide support to the Government and the humanitarian community by disseminating data on IDPs for ensuring effective humanitarian response to the affected population.

Emergency tracking teams and enumerators are deployed to Ancuabe, Namuno, Balama, Chiure, Ibo, Mueda, Nangade, Montepuez, Palma, Mecufi, and Cidade de Pemba districts to collect data on displacement movements on a daily basis. Due to recent attacks, the DTM team has temporarily stopped assessments in Macomia, Muidumbe, and Mocimboa da Praia districts.
