

Daily Press Briefing by the Office of the Spokesperson for the Secretary-General

The following is a near-verbatim transcript of the noon briefing by Farhan Haq, Deputy Spokesman for the Secretary-General, on 25 March

We are following closely the situation in Palma town and the attacks that reportedly began on 24 March and continue today. There's limited information on the incidents so far. We remain concerned about the violence in Cabo Delgado Province, which is driving increased displacement of populations and leading to a rapid deterioration of the humanitarian situation in the region. The United Nations stands ready to continue to support the people and the Government of Mozambique in urgently addressing the humanitarian needs of the affected populations.
