UNHCR expresses condolences upon death of Rwandan refugee in Mozambique, urges swift investigation

UNHCR, the UN Refugee Agency, expresses its deepest condolences on the tragic death of Revocant Karemangingo, vice-president of the Rwandan Association in Mozambique, and calls for a swift, thorough investigation and accountability for the perpetrators.

Mr Karemangingo was shot in Maputo's Liberdade neighborhood on Monday afternoon. He was known to UNHCR as an example of resourcefulness for his efforts to integrate and contribute to Mozambican society.

UNHCR extends its condolences to Mr Karemangingo's family, the Rwandan Association in Mozambique and all refugees and asylum seekers who may be affected by this tragedy.
